Mistaken Identity – Have You Forgotten Who You Are? (SMBC 2021)

Scripture Text: 1 John 1:9

Identity: (noun) the fact of being who or what a person or thing is.

Our identity has a lot to say about us; it can be influenced or affected by a slew of things:

- Job
- Neighborhood
- Family
- Hobbies
- Education
- Friendship circle

Our purpose: for those who have fallen away, to see where you were; how you got where you are; and how to get back to where you were.

## 1. Who Were You?

- A. A Christian
  - 1. How do we become a Christian? Hear, believe, repent, confess, baptism
  - 2. Examples put into practice:
    - a. Cornelius Ac. 10 & 11 Ac. 11:13-14
    - b. Eunuch **Ac. 8:36** "what doth hinder me?"
    - C. Jailer Ac. 16:33 same hour, straightway, immediately
- B. Why are we called Christians?
  - 1. Ac. 20:28 Jesus shed His Blood
  - 2. **Gal. 2:20** crucified with Christ

## 2. What Separated You?

- A. Sin
  - 1. Defined: "missing the mark." 1 John 3:4
  - 2. Commission vs. Omission James 4:17
  - 3. "It is always right to do right. It is always wrong to do wrong. It is never right to do wrong. It is never wrong to do right. And that's right because the Bible's right." Dan Jenkins

Mistaken Identity 1/2

- B. What does the Bible say?
  - 1. **Isa. 59:1-2** it is not God's fault
  - 2. **Rom. 3:23** all sin not an excuse to sin!
  - 3. **Rom.**  $6:23 \sin = \text{death}$
  - 4. **2 Peter 2:20-22** scariest verses: danger of falling away; better if hadn't known

## 3. How Do I Get Back?

- A. Must realize the need
  - 1. **Lk. 15:17** prodigal son came to himself
  - 2. Feel like your life is in a circle with no hope to get out? Stop and turn to God!
- B. What does the Bible say?
  - 1. **1 John 1:9** confess our sins & He will forgive
  - 2. **James 1:21-25** man who forgets what he looks like
  - 3. **Rev. 2:1-7** church at Ephesus
    - a. Previously had a doctrine problem, **Ac. 20:28-30**, **1 Tim. 4:3** (Timothy in Ephesus)
    - b. Now has a love problem remember your first love
    - c. Key to fixing the problem: <u>repent</u>!

What if you've never obeyed the Gospel? See the steps in point 1.

What if you're a Christian and faithful? Keep pressing forward!

What if you've forgotten your identity? See the steps in point 3.

Remember: **Rom. 8:1** – no condemnation in Jesus Christ!

We've looked at <u>32</u> verses now, "what will you do with Jesus? The question comes to you! What shall your answer be?"
