Imperfect Verb Tense

- Combines past tense and imperfective (continuing or repeated event or state)
- In English: past progressive (i.e. was doing)
- 17 High priest probably Caiaphas, Ac. 4:6
 - Sect hairses in Greek; heresy in English
 - Jealous of Jesus' popularity, Mt. 27:18, Mk. 15:10
- 18 Public prison custody publicly
 - Attempt to discredit by arresting
- 19 Details of how the release occurred might by similar to the events in Ac. 12
- "Irony: as the council gathered to decide how to put an end to the preaching about Jesus, the men they arrested were preaching Jesus a few hundred feet away." [Roper]
 - "Most powerful body in Palestine was in for a great shock." [Roper]
- In Acts, when the apostles were arrested, they offered no resistance
- The name of Jesus was on every tongue
- 30 Preached a short sermon 56 words in English, 50 words in Greek
- 31 First time "Savior" is used in Acts
 - "Savior" would infuriate the council
