David & Bathsheba

Scripture Text: 2 Kings 11, 12, Psalm 51

- David is the 2nd King of Israel
- This story illustrates the love of God, the destructiveness of sin, and the process of repentance
- Scene: Israel is at war
- 1 Samuel: David as boy/Saul as king;
 - 2 Samuel: David as king/(Solomon as boy);
 - 1 Kings: Solomon as king/Divided kingdom

1. The Sin – 2 Samuel 11:1-5

- 1 David has not gone into battle yet
- 2 evening: he sees Bathsheba taking a bath
- 3 asks who she is, an "army wife"
- 4 David has Bathsheba brought unto him
- 5 Bathsheba: "I am with child."
 David: "What have I done? What will I do?"

2. The Coverup – 2 Samuel 11:6-27

- 6 David asks for Uriah
- 7 making this look legitimate
- 8 Uriah sent to his house with a feast
- 9 Uriah (a just man) refused to go inside
- 10 David questions Uriah
- 11 "my soldiers are not home, neither am I"
- 12 David made him stay
- 13 David made Uriah drunk to cover his sin!
- 14 Uriah must take a letter to front line
- 15 letter: put Uriah up front
- 16 Joab following orders
- 17 Uriah died; David thinks "all is well"
- 18 Joab tells David all

David & Bathsheba 1/2

- 19-21 a great coverup story
- 22-24 rehearsed the story; Uriah is dead
- 26 Bathsheba mourns the death of Uriah
- 27 David brought Bathsheba to his house and she becomes his wife

3. The Punishment – 2 Samuel 12:1-24

- 1-6 Nathan the prophet's story
- 7 "Thou art the man!" Imagine the courage
- 9 why have you done this evil?
- 13 David admits his sin
- 15 David & Bathsheba's son struck with sickness v. 18 child dies
- 20 in the face of death, David worshiped
- 21 servants wonder why he worshiped
- 23 David: "I can't bring him back but I can go where he is"
- 24 another son born: Solomon (God's redemptive nature shown)

(Lessons) How to Handle Sin - Psalm 51

- 1. V.3-4 acknowledge you have sinned
- 2. V.7 purge the sins (repent)
- 3. V.10-12 live life anew
- 4. V.13 teach others not to do what you did
